8 Sheriff's Office, at the suggestion of the Squaxin Island Police, investigated the allegations of abuse
9 and was able to confirm that the foster care providers physically abused _____. Upon
10 confirming the abuse, the Sheriff's Office contacted CPS and the children were immediately removed
11 from the foster care providers. Please see the attached police report.

12 5. At the direction of ICW, the children were placed with relative _____ , who lives on the
13 Squaxin Island Reservation.

14 Therefore, based on the foregoing, it is hereby ORDERED:

15 1. An emergency change of placement from _____ to _____ is granted.

16 2. The youth shall remain in the physical custody of _____, _____, Shelton,
17 Washington 98584.

18 3. _____ is authorized to provide all necessary medical, dental, educational and other
19 care as recommended by the youth's health care providers.

20 4. _____ is bound by any previous Court orders; copies of such order shall be
21 provided to her by the Court Clerk as convenient for the Court Clerk.

22 5. This Order shall be served on all parties. If any party objects to the entry of this Order, he or
23 she may submit a written objection to the Court within seven days of the date on this Order; otherwise,
24 this Order shall stand as entered on this date.
